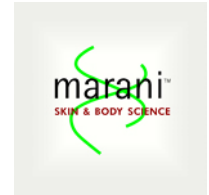

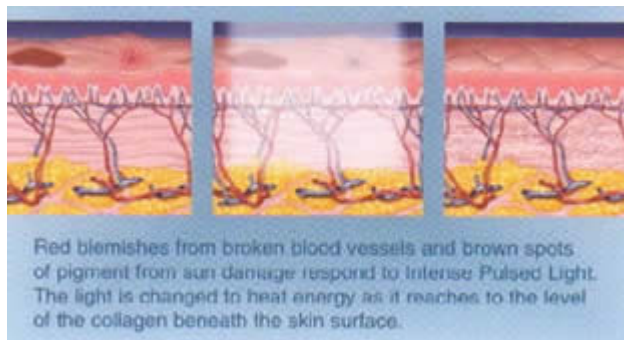
Flawless Skin Photo Rejuvenation

Photo Rejuvenation with an Intense Pulsed Light System, is a non-invasive treatment breakthrough that can correct a variety of skin conditions, such as facial skin imperfections, signs of aging (wrinkles), birthmarks, unsightly small veins and other blemishes. It offers a safe, non-invasive solution that can be tailored to your individual condition and skin type, providing superior cosmetic results and outstanding satisfaction.

What are the treatment sessions like?

Quick and Easy! After initial preparation, the therapist will move the hand piece over your skin. The hand piece emits light that is transformed into heat as it reaches the collagen beneath the surface of the skin.

Most people perceive the light as a gentle 'snapping' sensation.



Why are multiple treatments necessary?

Depending on the number of conditions you are treating, and the severity of the individual problem, a series of five or six treatment sessions may be recommended. Blemishes often clear after 1 or 2 treatments but for deeper vascular / pigmented areas such as birthmarks more treatments may be necessary. You can return to work the same day and resume all your regular activity. By dividing the full program into several treatments, the procedure provides gradual improvement with very low risk. It preserves the "no downtime" feature that people appreciate so much.

How do other treatments compare to Photo Rejuvenation?

While there are lasers that treat red spots, other lasers treat browns and others yet that are used for resurfacing of facial skin, no technology provides the long-term improvement of complexion and texture of the IPL Photo Rejuvenation system used. Many laser procedures require local anaesthetic and result in months of recovery from painful burns and increased redness of the treated areas. Photo Rejuvenation causes minimal redness which resolves in several hours, thus causing no disruption of your busy lifestyle.

What conditions can Photo Rejuvenation treat?

Photo Rejuvenation is effective in the treatment of imperfection from sun damage and photo aging, dilated veins and capillaries and the symptoms of Rosacea. Enlarged pores, dull complexions and other facial imperfections or abnormalities can detract from your well being and appearance, no matter how healthy and young you feel. Today's IPL technology improves both the superficial and deeper skin layers and rejuvenates the skin while at the same time delivering beneficial thermal energy to deep tissues. After a series of treatments, you can see a significant reduction of unwanted pigmentation and the appearance of smoother, revitalized skin. The same treatment can be used effectively on the neck, chest, and the hands.

Photo Ageing which includes:

Microdermabrasion

Microdermabrasion is a technique used for removing the damaged, upper layers (stratum corneum) of the skin in order to reveal the more supple, radiant skin beneath, giving you an immediate improvement in your skin's appearance. The stratum corneum sheds naturally when we are very young, but as we age this process slows, allowing this layer to accumulate on the surface and to obscure the healthy cells below.

The controlled abrasion and suction of Microdermabrasion also prepares the skin for application of exfoliants, including Lactic and Vitamin A solutions, in order to reveal the younger, smoother, more evenly textured skin beneath as well as to promote new cell growth to plump fine lines, wrinkles and shallow scars. This method of skin rejuvenation on the face and body improves the overall look, feel, texture and colour of the skin; it can reduce pigmentation, large pores and soften acne scarring.

A course of Microdermabrasion treatments achieve a result that approaches that of a Chemical Peel, but is less invasive and usually requires no significant downtime. Normal activities may usually be resumed immediately after treatment, though there may be some flaking for 5 to 7 days. Softer, smoother and clearer skin is usually noticeable after the first treatment. Optimum results may require a series of 4 to 6 sessions over 12 weeks depending on the condition being treated and quality of the skin.

What is Microdermabrasion good for?

- Sun damaged skin- face, neck and shoulders

Diathermy

The use of electrical current to produce heat. This heat is used to cauterise (seal or coagulate) tissue and blood vessels. Electro-cauterisation offers a unique and preferable treatment procedure to eliminate vascular lesions, skin tags and warts.

Vascular Lesions

Vascular lesions occur when there is a concentration or enlargement of fine blood vessels. The medical term for these unsightly vascular blemishes is telangiectasia. Telangiectases are small dilated capillaries commonly called "broken capillaries" ("broken capillaries" would bleed under the skin and form a bruise, but this is not the case), thread veins, cherry angiomas (blood spots), spider naevi and spider veins (a small cluster that resembles a spider or star) which are usually dull or bright red. Whatever physical form the telangiectases take, they are by definition, dilated blood vessels.

There are many causes of Telangiectasia, hereditary plays a significant role in the development of these lesions. Hereditary Telangiectasia is a congenital weakness in the blood vessel walls. Telangiectasia may be present at birth while some other common causes are ageing, sun exposure, skin injury such as an abrasion, medical conditions such as high blood pressure and also temperature extremes of both hot and cold.

Diathermy can successfully treat smaller dilated blood vessels without injuring the surrounding healthy skin, whilst IPL is the preferred method for treating larger telangiectases.

Dilated capillaries of the upper or superficial dermis are essentially dysfunctional. They carry blood but are too large to nourish cells effectively. Hence the treatment causes no risk to the health of the skin

What are AHAs?

Alpha-Hydroxy Acids (AHAs) are non-toxic, natural substances found in various fruits, sour milk, aged wine and sugar cane. The primary action of an AHA is to loosen the intercellular glue (which holds cells together) by decreasing their cohesiveness thereby accelerating the shedding of abnormal cells in the topmost layers of the skin. Continued use of AHA products may result in a normalized, more compact top layer of the epidermis, retexturising and making the skin smoother. It also leads to increased collagen production in the upper dermis, resulting in reduction of fine lines and wrinkles. AHAs are part of the skin's natural moisturising factor and give superior hydration. They also have an anti-inflammatory effect. Darker skin types should avoid most alpha hydroxy acids due to the risk of hypopigmentation (patches of lightened skin).

What are BHAs?

Beta-Hydroxy Acids (BHAs) are a derivative of Aspirin and can also be found in pumpkin seeds, sweet birch, wintergreen leaves and willow bark. The primary action of a BHA is to act as a surface exfoliator, retexturing the skin by exfoliating old skin cells allowing for new younger cells to develop. BHAs penetrate more deeply than AHAs and along with retexturing and hydrating the skin, BHAs also have an effect on pigmentary disturbances and sun damage. BHAs or Salicylic acid is anti-inflammatory, anti-microbial and anti-bacterial making them excellent for treating oily and acne prone skin conditions. Salicylic acid may also make you peel. BHAs are not suitable for some people including pregnant or lactating women, dark skins and people allergic to Salicylic acid (Aspirin).

How do they work?

AHAs and BHAs thin the skin's outer layer. As we age, the outer 'dead' layer of the skin doesn't shed as rapidly as when we are young. The dead skin becomes harder and cross-linked, distorting the living tissue underneath, causing fine lines and wrinkles. AHAs and BHAs break this undesirable bonding between the surfaces enabling detachment of the microscopic 'dead' cells. This will expose the less damaged and youthful looking skin beneath. BHAs can also inhibit excessive melanin production eliminating hyperpigmentation.

How long will it take to work?

Within 2 weeks ~ Skin will look and feel softer and smoother.

The skin will acquire an overall healthy looking glow.

Within 4 weeks ~ AHAs and BHAs will effectively diminish the visibility of fine lines and wrinkles.

The skin tone will appear more even and radiant.

Who can use AHAs and BHAs?

AHAs ~ Men and Women except those with dark skin.

BHAs ~ Men and Women except those with dark skin, pregnant or lactating women and people allergic to Salicylic acid (Aspirin).
